Teams: Each team is composed of any five students from the same school who are in grades 6-8. A team may have students from different grades.

Tournament: *Individual round:* Each student works alone on 10 timed short-answer problems.

Team round: All 5 team members work cooperatively on another 10 timed short-answer problems.

Playoff round: If required, up to 5 additional timed problems will serve as tie-breakers for awards.

Fee: \$75 per team. One team will be accepted from each school until the registration deadline, **Friday, April 15**. Additional teams from these schools will then be accepted as space permits.

Chaperones: One parent or teacher per team is required — as a proctor.

Awards: All students will receive a certificate of participation. High scorers, both individual and team, will receive awards.

Food: Students and chaperones should bring their own snacks and sharpened pencils.

Calculators: Calculators will not be permitted for this event.
