- Science –Biology, Chemistry, Physics, AP Biology, AP Chemistry
- Other Subjects – AP European History, AP US History, Spanish, Korean
- Classes are 1 ½ hours a day / twice a week
- Tuition: \$720 per subject / 8 weeks *Class Size: 4-6 students*

**4. SAT JR – Level 1 and Level 2 6<sup>th</sup> grade through 9<sup>th</sup> grade**

- Designed to get a head start on preparing for the SSAT/ISEE, PSAT and SAT. The program offers Vocabulary, Critical Reading, Math and Writing.
- Classes are 4 hours a week
- Tuition: \$800 / 8 weeks *Class Size: 6-8 students*

- Tuition: \$300 per week / \$2100 per 8 weeks *Class Size: 8-10 students*

**How to register / Summer Apex Policy:**

- Summer registration begins April 1<sup>st</sup>.
- In order to reserve a spot in any class, return completed application with \$100 deposit per class.
- Full payment must be received no later than first day of class.
- No refund will be issued once classes have begun.
- No refunds for missed classes.
- Early Registration Discount: Sign up by April 30<sup>th</sup> and receive a 10% discount for each class.
- Sibling Discount: Receive 10% off one student cost when a sibling also signs up for a course.
- Referral Discount: Refer a student and receive \$25 off. Multiple referrals allowed.
- Up to two discounts may be applicable for each student.
- Registration ends on June 13<sup>th</sup>.
- We will be closed 4<sup>th</sup> of July – make up class will be August 22<sup>nd</sup>.
- Must take diagnostic tests – take about 1 – 3.5 hours depending on the grade level before being place in the class.
- A \$50 non-refundable registration fee is charged for first-time students.
- Apex reserves the right to terminate enrollment of any students at any time with or without reasons.
